
## Discussion Guide: 70% Dark Intentions by Amber Royer

- 1. How did you feel about felicity being called a, "Murder magnet?" Is that a fair assessment for someone who has been involved with two murders in as many months? Would you be as easily drawn into a second murder investigation as she is?
- 2. How do you think Felicity is progressing in her ability to deal with change? Has she come farther than she realizes? Or is she even more stuck? Is this different from the beginning of the book to the end? Why do you think the thought of changing her business model is so threatening to her?



- 3. Did Logan's volunteer efforts in this book change the way you thought about sea turtles, or endangered animals in general? Did you even realize there were endangered animals on the Texas Gulf Coast? How do the Turtles About Town sculptures play into this?
- 4. Which is a more charming animal companion in this book Knightley the bunny or Clive the octopus?
- 5. How does Felicity's relationship with Ash change over the course of this book? If you read the first book in the series, how is the way Ash talks about Felicity different in this one?
- 6. What do you think of Felicity's friends and acquaintances? If you read the first book, do you still have the same favorite characters? Or have they shifted? Do you feel like you've gotten to know more about who these people really are?
- 7. Why do you think Felicity feels such a connection between the copy of The Invisible Man that she finds on Mateo's bookshelf, and Mateo himself? Why does she feel responsible for finding him?
- 8. How do you feel about the changes in Felicity's relationships with both potential love interests, Logan and Arlo? As one relationship progresses and the other seems to be veering towards friendship, does it feel like Felicity is making the right choices? Does it feel like she might still change her mind?
- 9. At what point did you think you knew the outcome of the mystery? Were you right or wrong? If you guessed right, were you right about WHY the murder was committed? Were there any particular plot twists you enjoyed?
- 10. There's a lot of food mentioned in this book. Did any of it make you hungry? Would you try any of Mrs. Guidry's Cajun recipes? Anything Carmen bakes at Felicity's shop? What do you think of the fact that Carmen is now writing a cookbook?
